- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 6 "$ strips.
- (1) $13 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $13 / 4 " \times 3 "$ strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Orange (C), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 6 "$ strips.
- (1) $13 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $13 / 4 " \times 3 "$ strips.

From the Starry Basics - Cream (D), cut:
-(30) Template 1 triangles.
-(30) Template 3 triangles.

- (2) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $13 / 4$ " squares.

From the Dog House Multi - Blue (E), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 "$ x $6 "$ strips.
From the Starry Basics - Indigo (F), cut:

- (2) Template 2 triangles.

-(4) Template 2 triangles.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Teal (L), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 6 "$ strips.

From the Starry Basics - Gold (P), cut:

- (2) Template 2 triangles.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Steel (Q), cut:
-(2) Template 2 triangles.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Gold (R), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 6 "$ strips.
From the Starry Basics - Green (S), cut:
-(2) Template 2 triangles.

- (6) $11 / 2$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (5) $11 / 2 " \times 48 "$ strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (T), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 6 "$ strips.
From the Dog House Tonal - Cream (U), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 621 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 52 "$ strips.

## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Dog Allover - Red (V), cut:

- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $5 " \times 191 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $5 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 " $\times 66^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
- (2) 5 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) 5 " $\times 61 "$ strips.


## From the Houndstooth Basics - Black (W), cut:

- (1) $3 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $3 / 4 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $3 / 4 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) ${ }^{3 / 4 "}$ x 6 " strips.
-(2) Template 2 triangles.
- (8) 1 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 1" x $51 / 2 "$ strips.
-(10) 1 "x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 1 " x $61 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Dog Allover - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 69 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69 " $\times 83$ " back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 1 " $\times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric W strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1" $\times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric W strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1 ). Trim unit to measure 6 " square. Repeat to make (28) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) Fabric D-Template 1 triangle to the left side of (1) Fabric H-Template 2 triangle. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew (1) Fabric D-Template 3 triangle to the right side of the Fabric H triangle to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2). Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.
3. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 6 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 3). Pay attention to the unit orientation. Repeat to make a second Block One square.

5. Place (1) $13 / 4 "$ Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $13 / 4 " \times 3 "$ Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 18). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 18). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 19).

6. Place another $13 / 4$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the $13 / 4 " \times 3$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 20). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 strips total.

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## Quilt Top Assembly <br> (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

12. Sew together (1) Block Sixteen square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four square to make Row One.
13. Sew together (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Six square, (1) Block Seven square, (1) Block Eight square and (1) Block Nine square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Five.
14. Sew together (1) Block Ten square, (1) Block Eleven square, (1) Block Twelve square, (1) Block Thirteen square and (1) Block Fourteen square to make Row Three.
15. Sew together (1) Block Fifteen square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four square to make Row Four.
16. Sew together (1) Block Ten square, (1) Block Eleven square, (1) Block Twelve square, (1) Block Thirteen square and (1) Block Seventeen square to make Row Six.
17. Sew together the (6) Rows, in numerical order, and (5) $11 / 2 " \times 48$ " Fabric S strips, alternating them, to make the Center Block.
18. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 621 / 2 "$ Fabric $U$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 52$ " Fabric U strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Sew (1) $5 " \times 66^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric V strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 " x 61 " Fabric V strip to the bottom of the Center Block. Sew together (2) 5 " x $191 / 2 "$ Fabric V strips and (1) $5 " \times 23 "$ Fabric A strip, alternating them, to make (1) Top Border Strip. Sew the Top Border Strip to the top of the Center Block to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the orientation of the Top Border Strip.
20. Layer and quilt as desired.
21. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric L strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
22. Bind as desired.
