



Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Snowman Banner - Cream (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 41 ½" panel.

From the Swirl - Green (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 41 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 2 ½" squares.

From the Houndstooth - Cream (C), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Red (D), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 2 ½" squares.

From the Snowflake - Cream (E), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (11) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Plaid - Red (F), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (22) 2 ½" squares.

From the Starry Basics - Tan (G), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (11) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Swirl - Red (H), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (22) 2 ½" squares.

From the Swirl - Lt. Blue (I), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 28 ½" WOF strips.

From the Snowflake - Red (J), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 28 ½" WOF strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Plaid - Green (K), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 28 ½" WOF strips.

From the Snowflake - Blue (L), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Starry Basics - Cream (M), cut:

• See instructions to cut (4) snowflakes.

From the Houndstooth - Blue (N), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 ½" strips.

From the Snowman Allover - Blue (O), cut:


- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 63 ½" strips.
- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 53 ½" strips.

From the Plaid - Blue (Backing), cut:

• (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 81" back.

Sewing Instructions


1. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.







2. Place another 2 ½" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) DCD unit.





- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (12) DCD units.
- 4. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (11) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric E strip and (22) 2 ½" Fabric F squares to make (11) FEF units (Fig. 5).
- 5. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (11) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip and (22) 2 ½" Fabric H squares to make (11) HGH units (Fig. 6).





- 6. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about ½" outside the drawn lines.
- 7. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

- 8. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (4) Fabric M snowflakes onto (4) 6 ½" Fabric L squares (Fig. 7).
- 9. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (4) Snowflake blocks.






10. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric I, (1) 2 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric J and (1) 2 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric K strips together lengthwise to make (1) KJI short strip. Repeat to make a second KJI short strip (Fig. 8).



11. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric I, (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric J and (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric K strips together lengthwise to make (1) KJI long strip. Repeat to make a second KJI long strip (Fig. 9).



12. Sew (1) 2" x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 10).



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Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 13. Sew (11) assorted units together end to end to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric B square, (6) assorted units and (1) 2 ½" Fabric B square together in that order to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) KJI long strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Snowflake block to each end of (1) KJI short strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center block to make the quilt top.

- 16. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric N strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 43 ½" Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 17. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 18. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 19. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.
