## Cutting Instructions - Both Versions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Banner Panel - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $231 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Plaid - Brown (B), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 271 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(3) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 591 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 43 "$ strips.

From the Continuous Block - Red (C), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (D), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x $71 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Lime Green (E), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Red (F), cut:

- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $71 / 8 "$ strips.
- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x $101 / 4 "$ strips.

From the Argyle - Red (G), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $71 / 8 "$ strips.
-(1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x $101 / 4 "$ strips.
From the Pawprint - Cream (H), cut:
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " $\times 71 / 8 "$ strips.
-(1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x $101 / 4 "$ strips.
From the Tag Word - Red (I), cut:
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $71 / 8 "$ strips.
-(1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x $101 / 4 "$ strips.
From the Travel Tonal - Teal (J), cut:
- (3) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4$ " x 57 " strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " $\times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Argyle - Green (K), cut:
Version \#1
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
Version \#2
-(8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Border Stripe - Light Blue (L), cut: Version \#2 only
-(2) $101 / 2 " \times 86 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

- (2) $101 / 2 " \times 67$ " LOF strips.


## From the Tag Word - Tan (Backing), cut:

Version \#1

- (2) $51 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 51 " x 70 " back.
Version \#2
- (2) 90 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71 " x 90 " back.


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Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$

Fabric B strip to each side of the $231 / 2 "$ x $421 / 2 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 271 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $26 " \times 45 "$.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric C square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Trim the block to measure $61 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric C square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). Trim the block to measure $61 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.
4. Sew together (1) 2 " $\times 71 / 8 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) $2 " \times 71 / 8 "$ Fabric H strip, (1) 2 " $\times 71 / 8 "$ Fabric G strip and (1) $2 " \times 71 / 8 "$ Fabric F strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 71 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4).
Repeat to make (8) Block Three rectangles total.
5. Sew together (1) 2" $\times 10^{1 / 4 "}$ Fabric I strip, (1) 2 " $\times 10^{1 / 4 "}$ Fabric H strip, (1) 2 " $\times 101 / 4 "$ Fabric G strip and (1) 2" x $101 / 4$ " Fabric F strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) $101 / 4 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Block Four rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Block Four rectangles total.

6. Refer to Figure 6 and sew together (4) Block Three rectangles, (2) Block Two squares and (1) Block One square to make the Left Side Border.
7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 7-9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, Top Border and Bottom Border.

## Version \#1 Quilt Top Assembly <br> (Follow Figure 10 while assembling the Version \#1 quilt top.)

8. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 57 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 591 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 43$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Version \#1 quilt top.

## Version \#2 Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow Figure 12 while assembling the Version \#2 quilt top.)
8. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 57 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 591 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 43$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Version \#1 quilt top.

## VERSION \#2 Only

12. Center (1) $101 / 2 " \times 86$ " Fabric L strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
13. Repeat Step 12 to sew (1) $101 / 2 " \times 67 "$ Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 10).
14. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 10), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make Version \#2 of the quilt top.

## Both Versions

15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric $K$ strips together for Version \#1 or (8) strips for Version \#2, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.
