





#### **Cutting Instructions - Both Versions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Banner Panel - Red (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 42 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Plaid - Brown (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 59 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (3) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 43" strips.

#### From the Continuous Block - Red (C), fussy cut:

- (6) 6" squares each centerd on an animal block.
- (6) 6" squares each centerd on a word block.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (D), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 6" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 8" strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Lime Green (E), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 6" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 8" strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Red (F), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 7 1/8" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 10 1/4" strips.

#### From the Argyle - Red (G), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 7 1/8" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 10 1/4" strips.

#### From the Pawprint - Cream (H), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 7 1/8" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 10 1/4" strips.

#### From the Tag Word - Red (I), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 7 1/8" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 10 \( \frac{1}{4} \)" strips.

#### From the Travel Tonal - Teal (J), cut:

- (3) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 57" strips.
- (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strips.

#### From the Argyle - Green (K), cut:

Version #1

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding. *Version #2*
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Border Stripe - Light Blue (L), cut:

Version #2 only

- (2) 10" x 86" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 10" x 67" LOF strips.

#### From the Tag Word - Tan (Backing), cut:

Version #1

- (2) 51" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 51" x 70" back.
- (2) 90" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 90" back.

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### Page 2

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

Center Block

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 42 ½"
Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A panel.
Sew (1) 2 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 26" x 45".






2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 6" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). **Trim the block to measure** 6 ½" x 6 ½". Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.




3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 6" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). **Trim the block to measure** 6 ½" x 6 ½". Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.




- 4. Sew together (1) 2" x 7 1/8" Fabric I strip, (1) 2" x 7 1/8" Fabric H strip, (1) 2" x 7 1/8" Fabric G strip and (1) 2" x 7 1/8" Fabric F strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) 6 1/2" x 7 1/8" Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (8) Block Three rectangles total.
- 5. Sew together (1) 2" x 10 ¼" Fabric I strip, (1) 2" x 10 ¼" Fabric H strip, (1) 2" x 10 ¼" Fabric G strip and (1) 2" x 10 ¼" Fabric F strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 10 ¼" x 6 ½" Block Four rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Block Four rectangles total.



- 6. Refer to Figure 6 and sew together (4) Block Three rectangles, (2) Block Two squares and (1) Block One square to make the Left Side Border.
- 7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 7-9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, Top Border and Bottom Border.

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Version #1 Quilt Top Assembly (Follow Figure 10 while assembling the Version #1 quilt top.)

- 8. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 10. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 57" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 40 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 59 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 43" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Version #1 quilt top.



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


Fig. 12

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

### Version #2 Quilt Top Assembly (Follow Figure 12 while assembling the Version #2 quilt top.)

- 8. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 10. Sew (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 57" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 59 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 43" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Version #1 quilt top.

#### **VERSION #2 Only**

- 12. Center (1) 10" x 86" Fabric L strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 13. Repeat Step 12 to sew (1) 10" x 67" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 10).
- 14. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 10), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ½" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make Version #2 of the quilt top.



#### **Both Versions**

- 15. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 16. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric K strips together for Version #1 or (8) strips for Version #2, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 17. Bind as desired.
