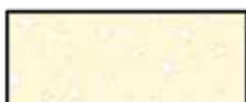

Brown Version - Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the No Fowl Blocks - Red (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 20 1/2" x 23 1/2" WOF strip. (The other half of the panel can be used for the Blue version quilt.)

From the Flower Toss - Brown (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 23 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (36) 1 1/4" squares.

From the Small Character Toss - Lt. Teal (C), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Argyle Texture - Red (D), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Large Character Toss - Tan (E), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Flower Toss - Pink (F), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 1/4" x 2" strips.

From the Starry Basic - Red (G), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 1/8" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Flower Toss - Dk. Teal (H), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 41" WOF strips.
- (2) 3 1/4" x 42 1/2" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starry Basic - Tan (I), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Small Character Toss - Green (J), cut:

- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips.

From the Small Character Toss - Brown (K), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 55 1/2" strips.

From the Small Character Toss - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 63" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 63" x 67" back.

Brown Version - Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 3" x 23 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 1/2" x 23 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 27 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

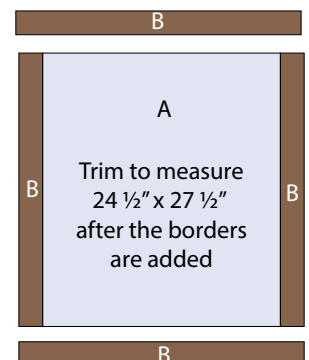

2. Place 3 1/8" Fabric F square on top of (1) 3 1/8" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) FG units (Fig. 4). Trim the FG units to measure 2 3/4" square. Repeat to make (16) FG units total.

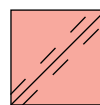

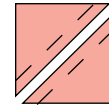

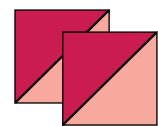

3. Sew (4) FG units together to make (1) Unit 1 (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1's total.

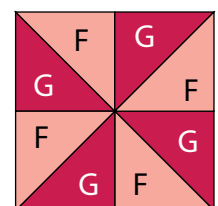

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4. Place (1) 1 ¼" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) 1 ¼" x 2" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

5. Place another 1 ¼" Fabric B square on the right side of the 1 ¼" x 2" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2.

6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (16) Unit 2's total.

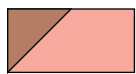

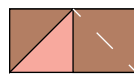

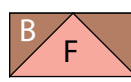

7. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the left side of (1) 1 ¼" Fabric B square. Sew only ½ way down the square (Fig. 10) to make (1) B block.

8. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the top of the B block (Fig. 11).

9. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the right side of the B block (Fig. 12).

10. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the bottom of the B block (Fig. 13).

11. Finish sewing the first seam of the B block to complete (1) Unit 3 (Fig. 14).

12. Repeat Steps 7-11 to make (4) Unit 3's total.

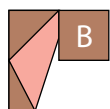

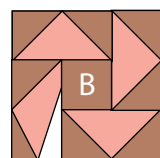

13. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x WOF Fabric J strip to each side of (1) 1 ¼" x WOF Fabric H strip lengthwise to make (1) JHJ strip set (Fig. 15).

14. Cut the JHJ strip set into (8) 2 ¾" x 5" Unit 4's (Fig. 16).

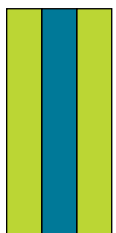
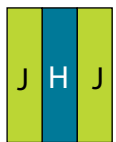

15. Sew (1) Unit 4 to the left side of one Unit 1 lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 3 to the left end of (1) Unit 4. Sew this strip to the top of the Unit 1 to make (1) Block One (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.

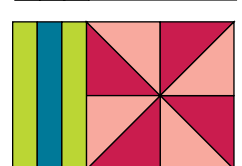

16. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strip and (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strip together lengthwise to make (1) IG strip set (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (6) IG strip sets total.

17. Cut the IG strip sets into (96) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Unit 5's (Fig. 19).

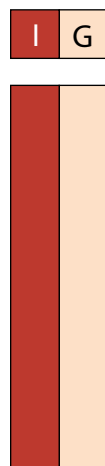

Brown Version - Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to Figure 20 while assembling.)

18. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip and (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) Side Strip. Repeat to make a second Side strip.

19. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip and (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) Top/Bottom Strip. Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Strip.

20. Sew (1) Side Strip to each side of the Center Block.

21. Sew (1) Block One to each end of (1) Top/Bottom Strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

22. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 41" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

23. Sew (23) Unit 5's together lengthwise and alternating their direction to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border. Sew (1) border to each side of the Center Block.

24. Sew (25) Unit 5's together lengthwise and alternating their direction to make (1) Top/Bottom Border. Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Border. Sew the borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

25. Sew (1) 3 " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

26. Layer and quilt as desired.

27. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

28. Bind as desired.

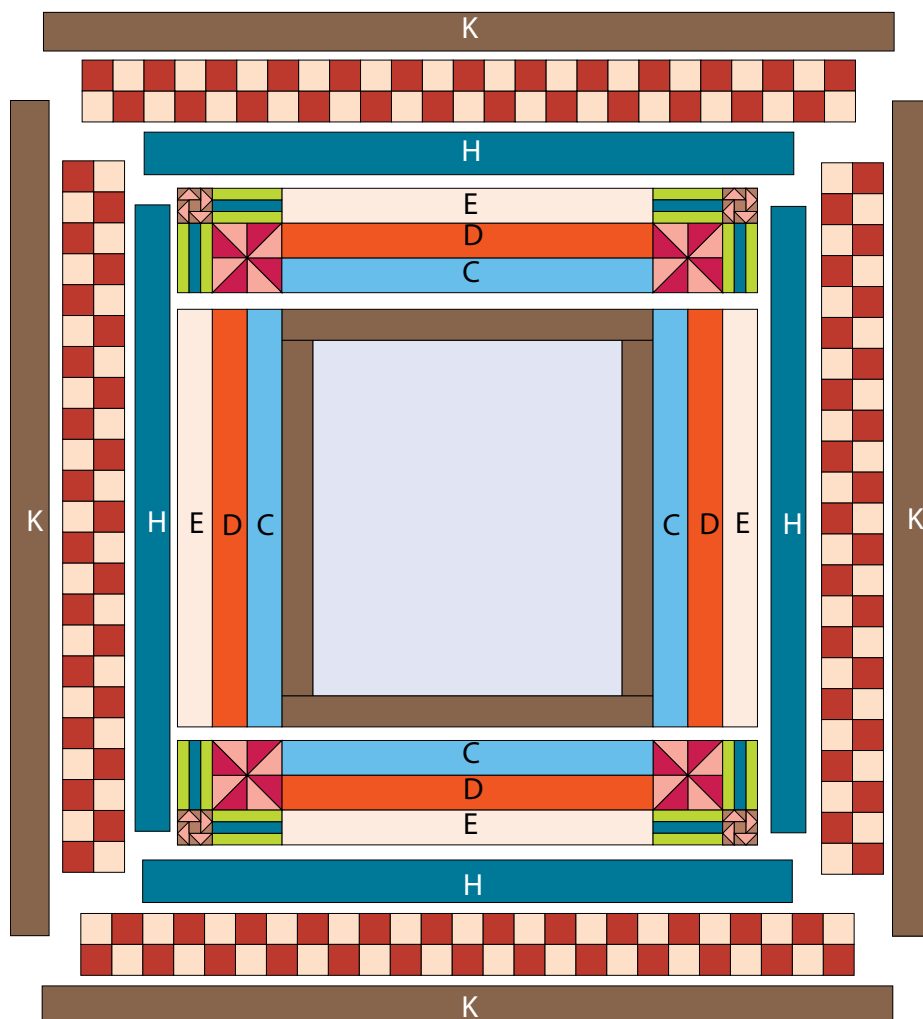

Blue Version - Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the No Fowl Blocks - Red (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 20 1/2" x 23 1/2" WOF strip. (The other half of the panel can be used for the Brown version.)

From the Flower Toss - Dk. Teal (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 23 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips.

From the Small Character Toss - Green (C), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip.

From the Argyle Texture - Brown (D), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Flower Toss - Brown (E), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (36) 1 1/4" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starry Basic - Cream (F), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 1/4" x 2" strips.

From the Argyle Texture - Red (G), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 1/8" squares.

From the Small Character Toss - Lt. Teal (H), cut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 41" WOF strips.
- (2) 3 1/4" x 42 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Starry Basic - Brown (I), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Houndstooth - Green (J), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Large Character Toss - Dk. Teal (K), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 55 1/2" strips.

From the Large Character Toss - Tan (Backing), cut:

- (2) 63" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 63" x 67" back.

Blue Version - Sewing Instructions

29. Sew (1) 3" x 23 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 1/2" x 23 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 27 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 21).

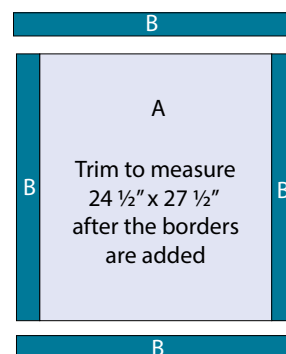

30. Place 3 1/8" Fabric F square on top of (1) 3 1/8" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 22). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 22). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 23) to make (2) FG units (Fig. 24). Trim the FG units to measure 2 3/4" square. Repeat to make (16) FG units total.

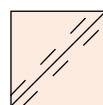

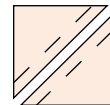

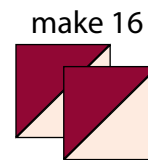

31. Sew (4) FG units together to make (1) Unit 1 (Fig. 25). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1's total.

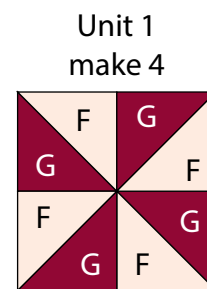

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32. Place (1) 1 ¼" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 1 ¼" x 2" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 26). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 26). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 27). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

33. Place another 1 ¼" Fabric E square on the right side of the 1 ¼" x 2" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 28). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 28). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 29). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2.

34. Repeat Steps 32-33 to make (16) Unit 2's total.

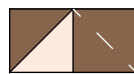

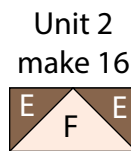

35. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the left side of (1) 1 ¼" Fabric E square. Sew only ½ way down the square (Fig. 30) to make (1) E block.

36. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the top of the E block (Fig. 31).

37. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the right side of the E block (Fig. 32).

38. Sew (1) Unit 2 to the bottom of the E block (Fig. 33).

39. Finish sewing the first seam of the E block to complete (1) Unit 3 (Fig. 34).

40. Repeat Steps 35-39 to make (4) Unit 3's total.

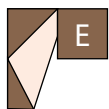

42. Cut the BCB strip set into (4) 2 ¾" x 5" Unit 4's (Fig. 36).

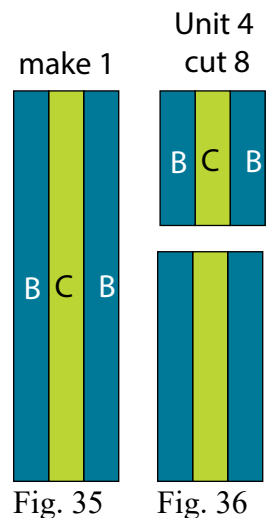

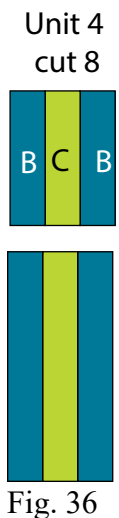

43. Sew (1) Unit 4 to the left side of one Unit 1 lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 3 to the left end of (1) Unit 4. Sew this strip to the top of the Unit 1 to make (1) Block One (Fig. 37). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.

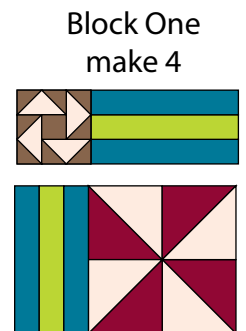

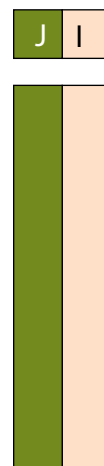

Blue Version - Quilt Top Assembly

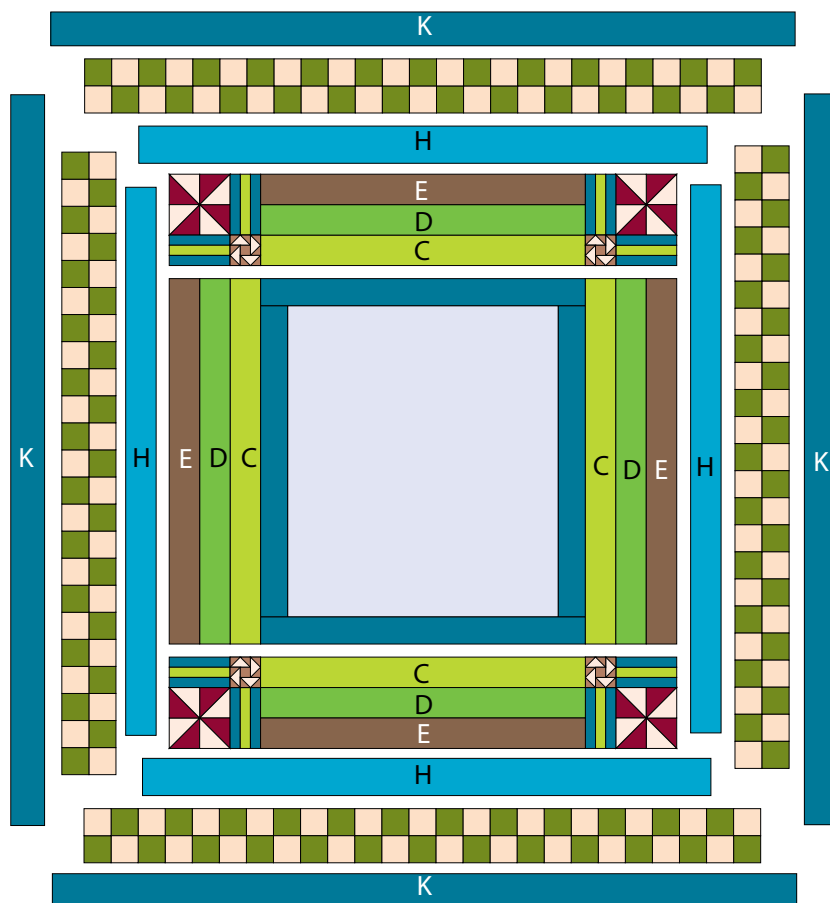


Fig. 40

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

(Refer to Figure 40 while assembling.)

46. Sew (1) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) 2 3/4" x 27 1/2" Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) Side Strip. Repeat to make a second Side strip.

47. Sew (1) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) 2 3/4" x 24 1/2" Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) Top/Bottom Strip. Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Strip.

48. Sew (1) Side Strip to each side of the Center Block.

49. Sew (1) Block One to each end of (1) Top/Bottom Strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

50. Sew (1) 2 3/4" x 41" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 1/4" x 42 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

51. Sew (23) Unit 5's together lengthwise and alternating their direction to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border. Sew (1) border to each side of the Center Block.

52. Sew (25) Unit 5's together lengthwise and alternating their direction to make (1) Top/Bottom Border. Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Border. Sew the borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

53. Sew (1) 3" x 54 1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 55 1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

54. Layer and quilt as desired.

55. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

56. Bind as desired.
