

Materials

1 panel	Growth Chart – White	8221P-04
1 panel	Blocks – Green	8219-66
⅓ yard	Houndstooth – Grey	8224-11 (Binding)
Fat 1/8	Stars – Blue	8226-77
Fat 1/8	Houndstooth – Green	8224-66
Fat 1/8	Stars – Green	8226-66
Fat 1/8	Chevron – Orange	8223-35
Fat 1/8	Stars – Purple	8226-55
Fat 1/8	Chevron – Purple	8223-55
Fat 1/8	Houndstooth – Pink	8224-22
Fat 1/8	Chevron – Jade	8223-76
Fat 1/8	Dots – Jade	8225-76
Fat 1/8	Dots – Orange	8225-35
1 ³ / ₄ yards	Characters – White	8222-04 (Backing)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

From the Growth Chart - White (A), cut:

• Fussy cut (1) 10 ½" x 42 ½" strip, centered on the growth chart.

From the Blocks - Green (B), cut:

• Fussy cut the desired number of 4 ½" squares, each centered on a letter or monster. You will need a total of (24) 4 ½" squares between this fabric and the assorted Fabrics D-M. If you desire duplicate letters or monsters, you may need more than (1) panel.

From the Houndstooth - Grey (C), cut:

- (1) 4 ¹/₄" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into (18) 1" x 4 ¹/₄" strips and (8) 1 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₄" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x 22" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x 42 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From Fabric D through M, cut:

- An assortment of 4 1/4" squares to use in lieu of the Fabric B squares, where desired. You will need (24) 4 1/4" squares total between these squares and the squares from Fabric B.
- (10) assorted 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Characters - White (Backing), cut:

• (1) 30" x 62" strip for the backing.

Sewing Instructions

Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

- 1. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to make the center block.
- 2. Sew (10) assorted 4 ¼" squares and (9) 1" x 4 ¼" Fabric C strips together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block.
- 3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the center block.
- 4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 22" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the center block.
- 5. Sew (4) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strips, (2) 4 ½" Fabric B squares and (5) assorted 2 ½" x 4 ¼" strips together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the center block.
- 6. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 22" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the center block to complete the Growth Chart top.
- 7. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 8. Sew the (4) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 9. Bind as desired.
