$5 / 8$ yard Circle Star - Green (B)
$3 / 4$ yard Houndstooth Basics - Lt. Teal (C)
$3 / 4$ yard Bubble Dot - Teal (D)
1 yard Starry - Cream (E)
$1 / 8$ yard Tossed Characters - Yellow (F)
$1 / 8$ yard Circle Star - Red (G)
$1 / 8$ yard Bubble Dot - Brown (H)
$1 / 8$ yard Circle Star - Gray (I)
$1 / 8$ yard Tossed Characters - Teal (J)
$1 / 8$ yard Starry - Orange (K)
$1 / 8$ yard Bubble Dot - Red (L)
1 yard Houndstooth Basics - Brown (M)
$31 / 4$ yards Bubble Dot - Teal (Backing)
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Block Panel - Gray (A), fussy cut:
-(1) $281 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Animal panel.
-(1) $281 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Words strip.
-(6) $61 / 2$ " blocks.

## From the Circle Star - Green (B), cut:

-(4) 2 " x $311 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. From each strip, sub-cut (1) 2 " x $16^{1 / 2 "}$ strip and (1) 2 " $\times 61 / 2 "$ strip.
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Lt. Teal (C), cut:
- (5) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (4) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.


## From the Bubble Dot - Teal (D), cut:

- (4) 1 " x $301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (4) 1 " $\times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2$ " $\times 561 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Starry - Cream (E), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut the letters of your choice. Choice of name cannot exceed $301 / 2 "$ long.

From the Tossed Characters - Yellow (F), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strip.

From the Circle Star - Red (G), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strip and (2) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot - Brown (H), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strip and (2) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Circle Star - Gray (I), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strip and (2) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Characters - Teal (J), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strip.
From the Starry - Orange (K), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strip.
From the Bubble Dot - Red (L), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strip.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (M), cut:

- (1) 18 " WOF strip for letter background
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Bubble Dot - Teal (Backing), cut:
- (2) $56 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56 " $\times 68$ " back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $281 / 2 " \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric A Animal panel. Sew (1) 2" x $311 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $301 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $281 / 2 " \times 1 / 2 "$ Fabric A Words strip. Sew (1) 2 " x $311 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A Words strip. Trim the block to measure $301 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.

4. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H square to the top of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric I square. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to the top of the sewn strip to make (1) short GHI strip. Repeat to make a second short GHI strip.
5. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric H strip to the top of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric I strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric G strip to the top of the sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) long GHI strip.
6. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric A block to each end of the long GHI strip. Sew (1) short GHI strip to each end of the sewn block to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 4).

7. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 30^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric K strip to the top of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top of the sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).

8. Use the templates provided to trace your chosen name onto fusible web of your choice. Press the fusible web to the Fabric E strip. Cut the Fabric E letters out.
9. Press each Fabric E letter to the Fabric M strip that has been backed with fusible web of your choice. Cut the letters out of the Fabric M strips $1 / 4$ " larger that the Fabric E letter size to create the double letter effect.
10. Refer to Figure 6 to arrange and press the double letters onto the Unit 1 strip.
11. Finish the raw edges of each letter with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Five rectangle (Fig. 6).

12. Sew (1) 1 " $\times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Top/Bottom Pieced Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Pieced Border.

13. Sew (1) 1 " $\times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Side Pieced Border (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Side Pieced Border.

## Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

14. Sew (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) Block Four rectangle and (1) Block Five rectangle together lengthwise and in that order to make the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) Side Pieced Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block Three to each end of (1) Top/Bottom Pieced Border. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 561 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
17. Layer and quilt as desired.
18. Sew the (6) $21 / 2$ " $x$ WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
19. Bind as desired.
