$3 / 4$ yard Bubble Dot - Brown (C) 8885-38
1 yard Starry Basics - Tan (D) 8294-44
1/4 yard Circle Star - Green (E) 8884-66
3/4 yard $\quad$ Stripe - Green Multi (F) 8883-66
$1 / 2$ yard Starry Basics - Indigo (G) 8294-77*
$31 / 4$ yards Tossed Characters - Teal (Backing) 8882-76

## Red Version

1 panel Book Panel - Red (A) 8880P-88
1 yard Houndstooth Basics - Lt. Teal (B) 8624-76
$3 / 4$ yard Bubble Dot - Red (C) 8885-88
1 yard Starry Basics - Tan (D) 8294-44
$1 / 4$ yard Circle Star - Red (E) 8884-88
$3 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Stripe - Green Multi (F) 8883-66
$1 / 2$ yard Starry Basics - Indigo (G) 8294-77*
$31 / 4$ yards Tossed Characters - Yellow (Backing) 8882-33

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Red Version fabrics listed second in () if different from Green Version.
From the Book Panel - Red (A), fussy cut:

- (12) 8 " blocks.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Lt. Teal (B), cut:
-(5) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $2 " \times 8 "$ strips.
-(8) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $2 " x 11 "$ strips.
From the Bubble Dot - Brown (Bubble Dot - Red) (C), cut:
-(6) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
-(8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ x $111 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Starry Basics - Tan (D), cut:

- (11) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 3" x $11 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.

From the Circle Star - Green (Circle Star - Red) (E), cut:

- (2) 3"x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3" squares.


## From the Stripe - Green Multi (F), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 57 "$ strips.
- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (G), cut:
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Characters - Teal
(Tossed Characters - Yellow) (Backing), cut:

- (2) 57 "x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 57 " x $71 "$ back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 8 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $8 "$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2" x 11" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $91 / 2 "$ square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 blocks total.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ' x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

3. Sew (4) 3" Fabric E squares and (3) 3" x 11 1/2" Fabric D strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Strip. Repeat to make (5) Sashing Strips total.

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Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)
4. Sew (4) 3" x $111 / 2 "$ Fabric D strips and (3) Block One squares together, alternating them, to make (1) Pieced Row. Repeat to make (4) Pieced Rows total.
5. Sew the (5) Sashing Strips and (4) Pieced Rows together lengthwise and alternating them to make the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 57 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
7. Layer and quilt as desired.
8. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
9. Bind as desired.
