Class Name: Basic Beginning Quilting

Welcome to Basic Beginning Quilting. This is a series of six 3-hour sessions where you will begin your quilting journey and you will make new “quilty” friends. You will start with rotary cutting, create 9 patch and monkey wrench blocks, learn borders, make a quilt sandwich, quilt with a walking foot, and finally bind your awesome quilt. You will receive a quilt manual in your first class with all instructions illustrated and plenty of space for personal notes.

You should already be comfortable with your sewing machine. There will be homework with each class to reinforce skills learned in class.

Supply List

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking foot and ¼ inch foot
- Rotary cutter – 45mm with new blade
- Mat (at least 24 inches long)
- Machine needles – 80/12 sharp or Superior 80/12 top-stitch
- Rulers – 6 ½ inches x 24 ½ inches, and 12 ½ inch square
- Marking pens or pencils
- 505 temporary adhesive spray
- Safety pins (nickel free)
- Kwik Klip (recommended)
- Binding clips
- Batting – crib size
- Sewing kit – small scissors, seam ripper, tape measure, thin glass head pins, clips, etc.
- Thread 100% cotton to match project

Fabric – Non-Directional

- Background
 - (light) – 1 1/3 yard

- Color A
 - (medium) 9 Patch - 1 1/4 yard
- Color B
 - (dark) Inner Border and Monkey Wrench - 1 1/2 yard
- Outer Border
 - (medium) Can be same as Color A – 1 1/2 yard
- Backing
 - (any) Can be chosen after class begins – 1 1/2 yard
