Class Name: Desert Cove

Welcome to Desert Cove! Desert Cove is a great quilt for the sewist who has learned the basics of quilting and is ready to add new skills to her arsenal. This is a well written pattern which includes: constructing a rail fence block, creating a snowball, and making sashing with cornerstones. For this class, I suggest 40" x 54" option (sample size).

Supply List

- Pattern: Desert Cove by Nollie Bean
- Fabric: 8 fat quarters or 8 quarter yard cuts. You can also use jelly roll strips or random strips from your stash.
- Sewing machine in good working order that you know how to use
- New #80 sharp or topstitch needle
- Thread to match
- ¼ inch foot
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Rulers
- Sewing kit – small scissors, seam ripper, tape measure, thin glass head pins, clips, etc.

Before Class Preparation

- Cut 2 ½ inch strips (instructions on pg 4). DO NOT “sub-cut” background strips yet

Note: This is a 2-day class to allow ample time to master new techniques
