What: You will learn how to make a 16" diameter fabric bowl. Lori will teach you how to start with your foundation, add layers and visual elements of fabric to create a fabric bowl worthy of being a centerpiece in your home.

Supplies:

- ½ yard heavier weight Canvas fabric or heavier weight denim.
- 1.5 yards of 18" or wider Steam-a-seam or Heat-n-bond
- 2 Fat Quarters, one for inside, one for outside (or ½ yard each if you prefer. **NEED** the 18" width)
- *Teflon pressing sheet highly recommended. You will want to make more of these and it is very useful when using any type of iron on adhesive.
- Ruler and pencil for marking
- Scissors, rotary cutter, scrap fabric for decorating your bowl
- Decorative elements: Consider this a collage of sorts. You can review your stash, look at batiks, look for motif heavy fabrics such as large florals or prints with character.
- I used variegated thread for the inside and a solid color thread for the bobbin. Look at your fabrics to see what strikes your fancy.

Good scissors, pins, quilting clips, **GOOD WORKING SEWING MACHINE**, bobbins, thread, a new sharp needle such as an 80 - 90, for your machine as you are sewing through several layers of fused fabric. Paper towels and rubbing alcohol to clean your sewing machine needle as you sew. When using the adhesive, it can gum up your needle.
