Join Lori in making colorful, whimsical fluttering bugs to add fun elements to plants, shelves, gift packages, even create a mobile from these colorful creatures.

In class you will receive 3 patterns, a butterfly, moth and dragon fly, you choose the character you want to create in class, continue the buggy adventure at home. This is a strong beginner friendly project.

What to bring to class:

*Good working sewing machine, plug and foot, new #80 needle, thread, Large eye needle to accommodate embroidery thread.

*Basic sewing kit to include scissors and pins.

***Fabric** needs: This is a scrap/stash friendly project. Also consider, fat eights, and/or fat quarters.

For the body: (2) 9"x 3" fabric pieces can use same or different prints

Wings: (2) 9"x 6.5" and (2) 8"x 6.5" fabric pieces can use same or different prints.

Wing details: Various scraps at least (2) 3" x 3"

Batting for wings: can use scraps but do need at least "12 x 12"

Poly fiberfill for body, you will need a couple handfuls. Detailing items: Beads, buttons, embroidery thread, decorative thread, lace, pom-poms, yarns to cover wires if desired, yo-yos. Wire needed: 18 gauge 10" for legs, 22 gauge 6" for antennae.

**** NOTE TO STUDENTS:** Lori will bring poly fil, yarns and wire for your use in this class project.
