Turn your leftover Halloween color fabrics into a one-of-a-kind Witch Hat! In this creative session, you'll learn how to arrange your scraps to build a scrappy, textured foundation for your whimsical witchy headgear.

Supply list:

- **The Spellbound Hat pattern by Melissa Mortenson**
- Flannel 18" x 24" Color will not be seen
- Fabric strips, 70+, 1/2" wide or less x 19" long (the narrower your strips the more you need. Fat quarters are great for this project, your stash and your scraps.
- Fibers, yarns, ribbons, lace, bits and bobs to add dimension and interest
- Water soluble stabilizer such as Solvy 18" x 24"
- Lining fabric for hat top 18" x 24"
- Batting for hat top 18" x 24"
- Brim fabric for hat: 20" x 20"
- Brim lining 20" x 20"
- Stiff Stuff interfacing or similar product 20" x 20" *for brim
- Need bias binding for brim, to make your own need 1/2 yard of fabric, this too can be used for interior binding.
- Black Felt 5" x 6.5"
- Glue, such as Fabric Fusion to attach your bat applique to your hat.
- Good working sewing machine, (remember pwr cords and foot pedal), sewing kit to include scissors, rotary cutter, LOTS OF PINS! At least 100! Thread for your project, new machine needle, I recommend a #80. Consider variegated threads, have fun with this. If you have a free motion capable machine, this is a perfect project to learn how to use that capability. I will go through this technique in class.

- IT IS NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE FREE MOTION. A straight stitch is fine.
