#### Class Description:

Learn how to create a Windowpane Quilt. Instruction will include how to measure and cut your panel, how to border each square to create the windowpane effect. And finally, how to sew the squares together to finish your top piece.

#### Fabric:

- **Panel of your choice.** *Recommended size of 24' x 40". Choose a design that supports the idea of looking through a window out onto a landscape.*
- **Light colored fabric for base of windowsill** – 1/3<sup>rd</sup> yard (12" x 42")
- **Medium colored fabric for side of window frame**- 1/3<sup>rd</sup> yard (12" x 42")
- **Dark colored fabric for vertical and horizontal sashing**- 1/2 yard (18" x 42")  
*\*\*\*Solid color fabrics are preferred. If choosing a print, make sure it is non-directional*

#### Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good repair, ¼" seam foot, walking foot (if you have one), extra machine needles, bobbins, coordinating thread.
- Cutting Mat, Rotary Cutter, long ruler such as 6 ½" x 24 ½"
- Generic supplies: seam ripper, thread snips or small scissors.

#### Homework before class:

- **Take a picture of your panel for reference later**
- Make sure you know how to use your machine, how to change feet, thread, bobbins, and needles.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** As each panel is a custom size, we will work individually to measure and determine the sizes needed for your cuts. Do not cut any material in advance.
