Flying Geese are everywhere in quilting – from bold borders to elegant star points – and once you learn the technique, they unlock dozens of design possibilities. This beginner-friendly class guides you through the fundamentals of constructing accurate, beautiful Flying Geese units using methods that minimize fabric waste and maximize precision.



Fabric:

- 4-8 Fat Quarters (will be paired in groups of two, so choose fabrics that contrast and look good together)

Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good repair, ¼" seam foot, extra machine needles, bobbins, coordinating thread
- Cutting Mat, Rotary Cutter, long ruler such as 6 ½" x 24 ½"
- Pins, seam ripper, thread snips or small scissors
- OPTIONAL: (but recommended) Creative Grids Ultimate Flying Geese Tool

Homework before class:

- Make sure you know how to use your machine, how to change feet, thread, bobbins, and needles.
