Class Description: Part 1 – Resizing a quilt or blocks

Break down your quilts by math for simpler, more accurate construction! I'll explain and simplify the mystery behind making perfect quilts in this fundamental workshop. Learn how to change the size of your blocks for bigger or smaller quilts and create a cutting guide

Are you working with a quilt block or pattern but want to make things larger or smaller? It's easy to refigure the cutting instructions as you can't just increase the sizes of the pieces by a certain percentage.

Would you like to combine two or more pieced blocks to create a quilt that has a secondary design? Learn how to pick blocks that "play nice together".

Quilters use math all the time and we'll move beyond the "I hate math" mindset and make the numbers work for us instead of against us.
