



Scrappy Fiber Art Table Runner

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Learn how to turn scraps into a colorful, interesting, unique, one-of-a-kind table runner. A VERY STASH AND SCRAP FRIENDLY project. You will receive appliques in class for various versions.

In this class you will learn techniques for this project and leave with the ability to create more for any décor or occasion in future projects you choose to explore.

SUPPLIES:

- *WATER SOLUBLE STABILIZER 80" Long x 12" wide. Look at SULKY Water soluble SOLVY or PELLON Wash N Gone Stabilizer Either work.
- *80-100 Fabric strips $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide – $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide (**vary the width**) 12" long or longer. Can cut shorter when we are constructing the base.
- *A fat Quarter of white/light color flannel. Can be a print, but make sure it's light.
- *Colorful fabrics for your chosen applique. IE: Flowers, Pumpkin, Wording. I would suggest large scraps for florals, if creating wording, at least a Fat Quarter.
- *Up to 10 yards of colorful ribbons or yarns or fibers for accenting your table runner.
- *LOTS OF PINS!!!! At least 100 or more. YOU WILL USE A LOT OF THEM!!
- *Your sewing machine in good working order, please make sure you know your machine and have new needles, (80), thread for sewing. I used variegated threads in some of the projects.
- *Bring scissors, rotary cutter, pen and paper for notes.

HOMEWORK BEFORE CLASS, have your strips pre-cut BEFORE CLASS

$\frac{1}{4}$ " to $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide use scraps, fat quarters, fat eights, your stash. IT IS HELPFUL TO HAVE THEM SEPERATED BY COLOR.

***The instructor will bring fibers, threads, yarns and ribbons, however, please do not rely on this solely, as the colors may not coordinate with your chosen color scheme.**
