Class Description:

Welcome to Weekend Beginning Quilting. This is a fast-paced series of three 5-hour sessions where you will begin your quilting journey and you will make new “quilty” friends. Because we will be moving at a quick pace, we are hoping that you have done previous sewing and are very familiar with your sewing machine. Maybe you are a self-taught quilter and want a class to make sure you are doing everything correctly. Or maybe you took a quilt class many years ago and need a refresher to get you back in the groove. Or you have been a sewist for quite some time and want to transition to quilt making.

You will start with rotary cutting, create 9 patch and monkey wrench blocks, learn borders, make a quilt sandwich, quilt with a walking foot, and finally bind your awesome quilt. You will receive a quilt manual in your first class with all instructions illustrated and plenty of space for personal notes.

You should already be comfortable with your sewing machine. Make sure it is in good working condition. There will be homework with each class to reinforce skills learned in class.

Young sewists with machine sewing experience are welcome. Minimum age 15.

Fabric: – Non-Directional

- Background - (light) 1-1/3 yard
- Color A - (medium) 9 Patch 1-1/4 yard
- Color B - (dark) Inner Border and Monkey Wrench 1-1/2 yard
- Outer Border - (medium) Can be same as Color A 1-1/2 yard
- Backing - (any) Can be chosen after class begins 1-1/2 yard

Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order (bring owner’s manual if you have it)
- Walking foot and 1/4 inch foot for your machine (see attached page)
- Rotary cutter – 45mm with new blade (also have a spare blade)

- Rotary cutting mat (at least 24 inches long)
- Machine needles – 80/12 sharp or 80/12 top-stitch, hand sewing needle
- Rulers – required: one that is 6 ½ inches x 24 ½ inches, one that is 6-1/2” inches square; optional - one that is 12-1/2” square (highly recommended) (see attached page regarding 6-1/2” square ruler)
- Marking pens or pencils – no Frixion pens please
- 505 temporary adhesive spray
- Safety pins (nickel free, 1 inch) – curved are best
- Kwik Klip (recommended)
- Binding clips
- Batting – crib size
- Sewing kit – small scissors, seam ripper, tape measure, thin glass head pins, etc.
- Thread - 100% cotton – neutral or a color to match project. You may need two colors of thread, one for your piecing and one to do the quilting.

Be sure to ask for your 20% class discount in our store when buying supplies for this class.

Optional: small iron and ironing surface

Bring a sack lunch and/or snacks and beverages as we won't have an official lunch break.

Please be very comfortable with your sewing machine. Don't bring a machine that you have never sewn with before. **If you have one you haven't used for a very long time, dust it off and make sure it works properly and practice making a 1/4 inch seam.** You don't want to waste valuable class time trying to get your machine to operate as it should. If you need a refresher session on how to use your machine, contact the store to arrange a one-on-one tutorial for your machine.
