

Witch Whimsy with Lori

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Calling all Halloween fans let's make an exaggerated whimsical witch boot for your Halloween décor. You can hang it on your front door filled with fall and Halloween themed flora or fill it with goodies to bring to your Halloween festivities. Strap on your humor bag, bring your smiley face and join in on the fun, camaraderie and learn some new sewing tricks when making this Halloween inspired treat.

Supplies:

- **Witch Whimsy pattern (available at Modern Quilting)**
- **This is a scrap and fat quarter friendly project.**
- Fabrics: Front and back 7" x 18" (can use a fat quarter)
- Lining 7" x 18" (can use a fat quarter)
- Scallop top 6" x 22" (can use a fat quarter)
- Shoe 12" x 12" (can use a fat quarter)
- Toe and tab 12" x 12" (can use a fat quarter)
- Polyfill to stuff the toe
- **IF YOU WANT TO MAKE THE SCRAPPY VERSION you will need to bring a**

Piece of flannel 10" x 20" to use as a base to sew your scrap fabrics onto. Consider the colors of your scraps to choose the flannel color. Fabric strips approximately ¼" to ½" wide. Consider approximately 20, depending on the width. The narrower the strips the more you will need. Will need to be approximately 10" in length.

Threads, ribbons, yarns or fibers to add interest.

Consider a piece of water-soluble stabilizer to put on top, 10" x 20" it makes sewing the strips easier.

***IF you need flannel, water-soluble stabilizer and polyfil, contact instructor prior to class, you will get a kit for a separate charge of \$3.50 payable to the instructor at the time of class.**

Bring your sewing machine in good working order, scissors, pins, thread and a new machine needle. (Basic sewing supplies)

Bring your choice of beverage and a snack if you'd like to.
