CLASS DESCRIPTION: This is a great class for the confident beginner sewist. In this class you will learn the basics of garment sewing for a child's dress in the size of your choice. We will sew the top and lining of the dress with a finished hem including how to ease in the hem line. We will also be making a ruffle accent for the bottom to finish off the dress! Note: we will not be adding the piping option for this class. If time permits you can add the buttonholes and buttons, or snaps if you prefer (hook and loop tape is also an option)

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Lucy Pattern by Children's Corner Store

1 main fabric and 1 lining fabric- per pattern size plus $\frac{1}{4}$ yd of fabric for the ruffle. **NOTE:** depending on the pattern print date it may say $\frac{1}{8}$ yard for ruffle, this is incorrect. You will need $\frac{1}{4}$ yard for the ruffle.

Basic sewing supplies, including machine and pedal/power cords. General sewing thread to match the dress fabrics you choose.

Marking pencil, pins, clips(optional), extra sewing machine needles, point turner/purple thang, scissors

Homework: **Prewash** your fabric, iron after you dry it to get the wrinkles out. Cut out your main and lining fabric according to the layout directions (if you need help with this you can contact me at the store or by email or you can wait until class). You can also cut your ruffle fabric if you like.
