

**Class Description: Part 2 – calculating yardage requirements**

Have you seen a great quilt block and thought “That would make a great quilt but I want it to be smaller, larger, with/without borders, with sashing, etc.”? Then you wonder how much fabric you would need to make those changes to the quilt pattern. Was your chosen pattern written for precuts and you want to use yardage instead?

Use math to break down your quilts for simpler, more accurate construction! Learn how to calculate your fabric needs if you are building a quilt from scratch or changing the size. We’ll look at yardage for blocks, sashing, borders and binding.

Quilters use math all the time and we’ll move beyond the “I hate math” mindset and make the numbers work for us instead of against us.
