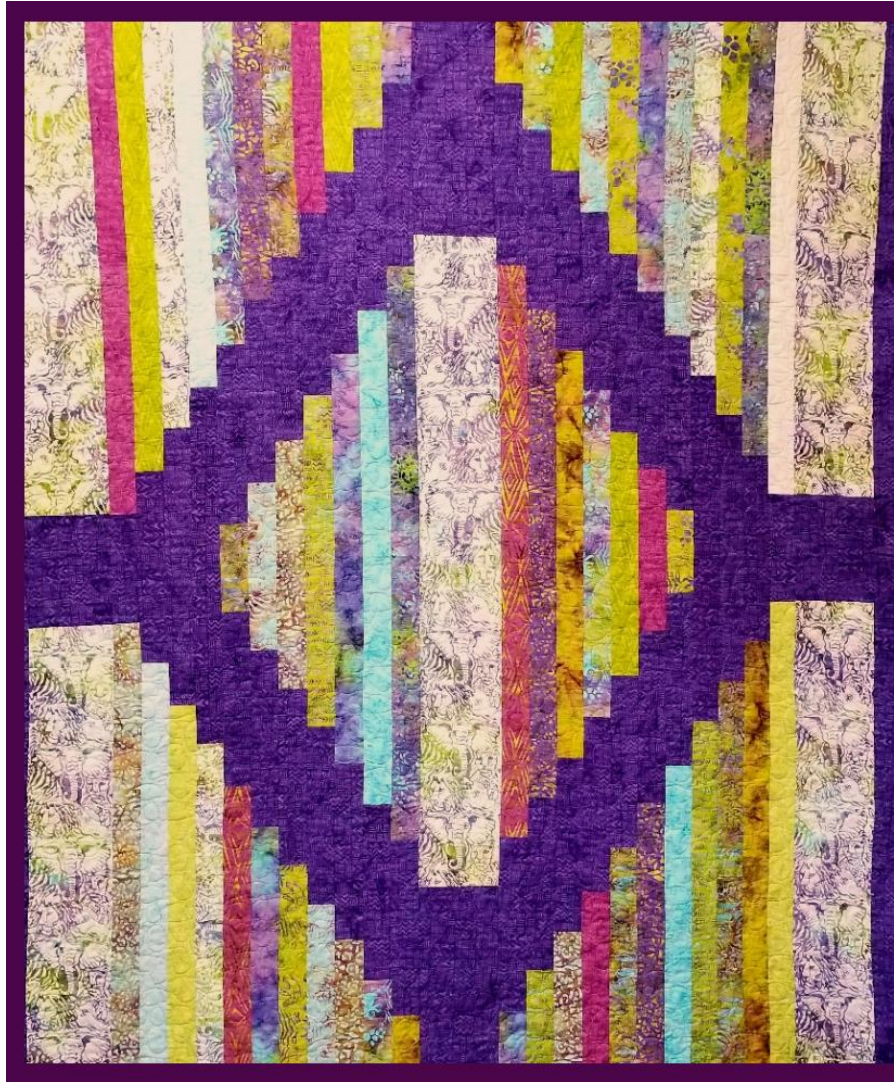

Where the Wild Things Are

Use the diagram for sub-cutting and layout.

Background = dark grey

Focal fabric = light grey

Strip pack = white



Background fabric:

2 – 6 ½" x WOF - sub cut

2 – 6 ½" x 8 ½"

2 – 6 ½" x 17"

23 - 2 ½" x WOF fabric strips – sub cut

28 - 2 ½" x 13 ½"

2 – 2 ½" x 26 ½"

2 – 2 ½" x 20 ½"

2 – 2 ½" x 14 ½"

2 – 2 ½" x 8 ½"

Focal fabric:

6 - 6 ½" x WOF strips – sub cut

4 – 6 ½" x 36 ½"

2 – 6 ½" x 24 ½"

2 ½" Strip Pack (or Jelly Roll):

Choose 33 strips that will pop against the background fabric.

Where the Wild Things Are

Trimming off the selvedge, sub-cut each strip from the strip pack, cutting all the longer strips that are 42 ½" through 24 ½" first. With remaining pieces of strips, begin sub-cutting all the 21 ½" through 6 ½" strips.

2 – 42 ½"	4 – 27 ½"	4 – 15 ½"
6 – 36 ½"	6 – 24 ½"	6 – 12 ½"
4 – 33 ½"	4 – 21 ½"	4 – 9 ½"
6 – 30 ½"	6 – 18 ½"	6 – 6 ½"

This pattern is easier if you have a design wall or large flat surface to layout your design and move strips around until you like the layout so that each strip is different and contrasting from the neighboring strips.

Using the Diagram, layout your strips as shown in Rows 1 through 25. It helps to pin a piece of paper with the row number to the top of each row.

Sew each of the strips together in each row.

Sew each row side to side. Vary the direction you are sewing rows together, either up the row or down. This helps prevent unintentional curving of the rows.

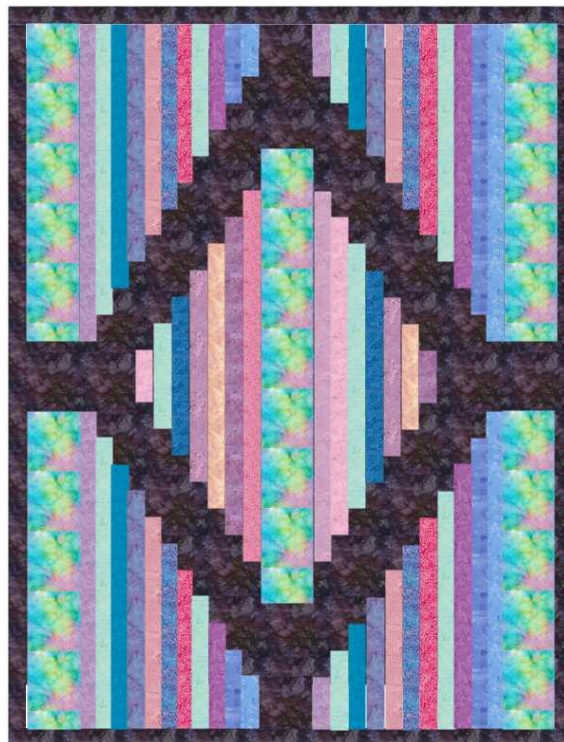
When all 25 rows are sewn together, measure and trim square.

Cut and sew a 2 ½" background border all around. Quilt and Bind.

Where the Wild Things Are

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 – 2 ½" strip pack (at least 33 strips) or jelly roll
- 2 yards of background fabric
- 1 1/4 yards of focal fabric
- 2/3-yard binding
- 4 ¼ yards backing (2 – 2 1/8 yds x WOF sewn selvedge to selvedge) or 2 1/8 yards wide back
