

# Class Information and Policies:

- We are keeping classes small for social distancing, but no longer require masks. Please feel free to wear one if it makes you more comfortable.
- Unless the teacher doesn't require it, we must have 3 students registered 7 days prior to class day or it will be cancelled and fees refunded.
- We try our best to publish class information at least a month prior to the class. If there is any missing information or class supply lists, please contact the teacher at the email listed on class info or the Stitch Studio.
- You must register 7 days prior to class day. Registration within the 7 days prior is usually okay, but at the discretion of the teacher and Stitch Studio.
- Cancellation of class by the teacher or Stitch Studio will be announced as soon as we know. This kind of cancellation will offer you a full refund of teaching fee or store credit, your choice.
- **Please check your schedule and be sure of your availability before registering for class. Your spot is held and becomes part of the number required for the class to make** and it wouldn't be fair for the other students who signed up to have it cancelled. If you find you can't make it to class, please do your best to find someone who would like to take your place in class or let us know and we can attempt to find another, as well. Regardless there is no longer refund or store credit for any class given by a paid teacher. **FOR SHOP TAUGHT CLASSES:** Cancellations greater than 7 days prior to class will allow you a full store credit. Cancellations 7 or less days prior to class day, will allow you a 50% store credit.
- If you are taking a multiple day class and find you will miss one class, teachers try to make time for a make-up class so you don't fall behind, but please let the teacher know as soon as you know to be sure that will be possible.
- **Thank you for your understanding concerning cancellations, refunds and credits. We are trying to be fair for everyone involved.**



## **Individual Class Requirements:**

Learn to Quilt with Rene Racho - Rene Racho – 210-392-3786 Beginner, with clear understanding of sewing machine use. Bring your serviced and working sewing machine and any sewing quilting tools you have. You will be discussing all the tools needed and have the opportunity to purchase when you don't have at a discount.

Beginner Quilting II: Rene Racho – 210-392-3786 Bring your pattern with Rene Racho - Advanced Beginner, having made previous quilt and knows basic cutting and piecing skills. Bring in a pattern you want to learn and Rene will teach you to make it. You will learn to read patterns and to perfect your techniques. Requires having taken the Learn to Quilt class or previous beginner quilting class. (Discuss with Rene prior to sign up.)

Collage Quilting – Linda Hasselberg 512-808-0490 Beginner, ability to do precise scissor cutting or rotary cutting depending on the pattern. -Bring your collage pattern, marking instrument, muslin or other foundation fabric. Learn to make a Collage -quilt using Laura Heine, Emily Taylor and Susan Carlson techniques.

- Purchase your pattern and fabrics from the Studio for a 10% discount. 10% Discount on anything day of class. We recommend Karen Kay Buckley's scissors for the fussy cutting.
- Each pattern has suggested amounts of Steam-a-Seam 2 Lite to purchase. Prep of fabric ahead of class makes it go easy. You will adhere the fusible to the backs of your collage fabrics and begin cutting out as many shapes or strips as you'd like. You'll need more than you think you will. We have a Sizzix Die Cutter available to use. We'll teach you how to use it. It also makes cutting go quicker.
- We prefer and suggest a light cotton instead of the Pattern Ease the designer uses.
- Must order your pattern a couple of weeks in advance if we don't have it in stock. We do keep many of them in stock, though.
- Please come into the shop for preparation instructions at least one week prior to class day.

T-Shirt Quilt Class- Melissa Shay 512-808-0490 Working sewing machine and sewing tools, rotary cutting rulers and rotary cutter, 4 to 9 Tshirts, clean and uncut, purchase yardage of cotton woven fusible stabilizer (available at the shop) and a yard of two or more fabrics to use in your quilt.

Straight-Line Quilting – Linda Hasselberg 512-808-0490 Working sewing machine and sewing tools, walking foot or even-feed foot to fit your particular machine. We have low shank walking feet available. Bring several fat-quarter size pieces of fabric and scrap batting to practice what you learn.

Applying Neat Binding by Machine – Linda Hasselberg 512-808-0490 Working sewing machine and basic sewing tools. Bring your practice quilting pieces or table runner size pieces of practice 'quilts' and ½ to 1 yard of any fabric to use for binding.

Embroidery & Embellishment - Linda Hasselberg 512-808-0490 Embroidery or other small scissors, embroidery needles, embroidery skeins, perle cotton, 12 wt. threads, lace, beads, ric rac, trims, buttons, charms, small finished appliques and any other embellishments you would like to add to your blocks, plus finished Crazy Quilt blocks or other fabric to embellish. Embroidery and Crazy Quilt Guide. You may purchase a kit of threads and embellishments from the shop.
