

# Spring Window Boxes

Long Table or Bed Runner, 78" x 24"

Add more rows and make a quilt!

Use your scraps for a cheery spring project

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## Yardage and Cutting Instructions:

(approximate measurements in parentheses allowing you to customize the size to your liking)

For each window:

Outside Window Frame – 2- 18 ½" x 2 ½" strips

1 – 8 ½" x 2 ½" strips

Inside Window Frame – 2- 13 ½" x 2 ½" strips

4 ½" x 2 ½" strips

Window – a variety of 8-2 ½" squares and 2- 2 ½"x3 ½"

Flowers – Fusible stabilizer on a variety of scraps to make 11 flowers

Leaves – Fusible stabilizer on green fabrics to make 6 leaves

Window Box – Brown – 8 ½" x 3 ½"

Sashing and Border- ¾ yard

Following the cutting instructions, piece your window frame with 2 ½" squares, 2 rows of four, sewn together. Sew 2- 2 ½" x 3 ½" and add to the bottom of the rows.

Add top inside frame, then sides. Add Window box brown to the bottom.

Add top outside frame, then sides.

Repeat for each window.

After applying fusible stabilizer and cutting out flowers and leaves, apply to each window, as desired. Stitch around each appliqué with either raw-edge straight stitching, zig-zag, or button hole stitch.

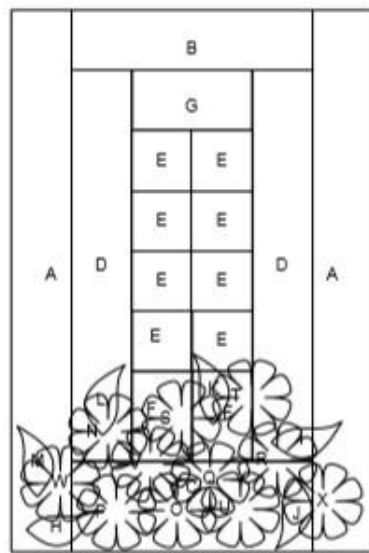
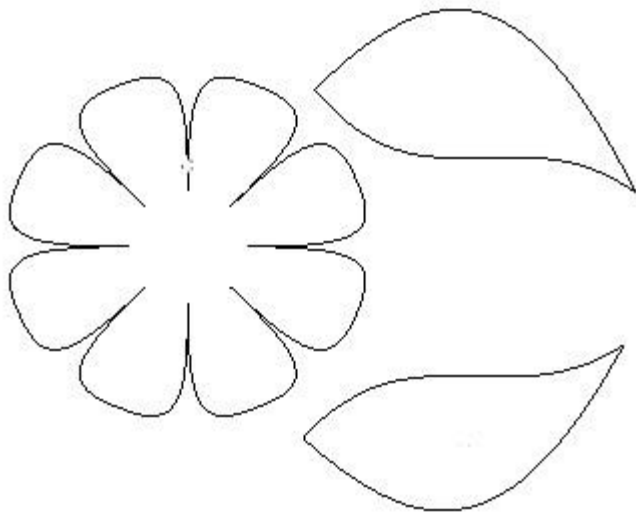
Cut 18 ½" x 3 ½" strips of sashing for each side of your windows.

Cut and piece 78 ½" x 3 ½" top and bottom borders.

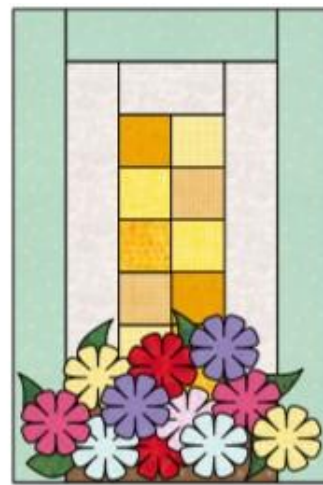
Complete your blocks, sashing and borders.

To make a quilt instead of a runner, repeat rows.

Quilt and bind as desired.
