23 Bankhead suggested recording oral histories for the generation after the one for which we already have
24 oral histories. The CLG grant is a matching grant.
- 25 • H Christenson asked if there were any appendices needed for the history book Providence and Her
26 People. S Bankhead explained there has been a lot of development over the last ten years. Providing an
27 update to the volume was suggested.
- 28 • H Christenson asked if there is a need or want to put a small plaque in front of the historical buildings that
29 are part of the walking tour. He felt it would create interest but was uncertain of the necessity. W Bitters
30 felt that the brochure had the pertinent information for the specific properties on the walking tour.
- 31 • W Bitters asked if the sauerkraut dinner has fizzled out. S Bankhead stated that it hasn't been held for
32 two years. P Perry felt that history should be important. W Bitters asked if there are any traditions that
33 should be brought back or created. A lighting ceremony around Christmas was suggested.
- 34 • S Bankhead stated that the founding celebration (1859) of Providence held several years ago in April was
35 quite successful. She explained that quilts were displayed.
