26 oral histories. The CLG grant is a matching grant.
27 • H Christensen asked if there were any appendices needed for the history book Providence and Her
28 People. S Bankhead explained there has been a lot of development over the last ten years. Providing an
29 update to the volume was suggested.
30 • H Christensen asked if there is a need or want to put a small plaque in front of the historical buildings that
31 are part of the walking tour. He felt it would create interest but was uncertain of the necessity. W Bitters
32 felt that the brochure had the pertinent information for the specific properties on the walking tour.
