Range Backpack

This one-day class will provide you with a great backpack for those day hikes or to use every day. You will have a lot of fun!

CLASS SUPPLY LIST:

Basic sewing supplies - thread, bobbin (or a couple) scissors, rotary cutter and small cutting mat, pins, fabric marking tool, etc.

Sewing machine in good working order. I encourage you to know your machine as I am not a sewing machine technician and know nothing about most machines, even mine works my brain to hard sometimes ;)

Range Backpack pattern

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard of exterior fabric which could be canvas, cotton or denim

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard of contrasting fabric for bottom

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of lining fabric (I like to use a cotton for the interior)

3 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards Fusible interfacing such as Pellon SF101. **NOTE** you will not need this if using canvas. You may also want to use fusible fleece or batting scraps if using cotton for your exterior.

$\frac{5}{8}$ Stiff Stuff interfacing.

8" zipper to match or contrast with your exterior fabric

2 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ rectangle "rings"

2 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ strap sliders

2 - 1" D rings for the closure or if you would prefer a parachute closure

Class preparation: Have your fabrics and interfacings cut out (do not fuse yet). Bring your leftover pieces to the shop for sew day in case you wish to make changes as we assemble.
