Supply List: All the Things Tote

Pattern Requirement*: All the Things Tote by Knot & Thread

Fabric/Material Requirements*: Please note that we will be making the medium-sized tote during class so that we can all be on the same page.

- Main Fabric - 1 yard
- Lining Fabric - 1 yard
- Accent Fabric (Binding & Handles) - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard
- ByAnnie's Soft & Stable - 18" x 58"
(For the small and Medium sizes, this should be enough. If you eventually want to make a larger size, I would recommend getting the 36" x 58")
- 1.5" Handle Webbing (polypro strapping) - 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Tools Required*:

- ByAnnie's Stiletto & Pressing Tool
- Tube Turner (Sookie Sews EZ Point and Turner OR Quick Turn Fabric Tube Turner)
- Coordinating Thread(s) - to match the exterior accent fabric & to quilt the main body
- Rotary Cutter
- Fabric Scissors
- 6.5"x24" Ruler
- Marking Tool (Chalk or Frixion Pen)
- Seam Ripper
- Clover Clips & Pins
- Bodkin (or one safety pin)
- Topstitch/Edgestitch foot (Bernina #10)
- Walking Foot
- Odif 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray

Pre-Class Homework:

1. Please have all your fabric purchased before the class.
2. Cutting Soft and Stable: It would be helpful if you could have your soft and stable cut before the class so that we can save time. Cut the soft and stable according to the diagram. (I am aware that 9.5" plus 9.5" is equal to 19", which is wider than the 18"x58" package. However, I often find that the width of the packaged soft and stable is just slightly wider than the 18" so try to get as close as possible 9.5".) If you don't feel confident doing this on your own, we can do it together in class! 😊
