Book Requirements*: Freemotion Meandering by Angela Walters

Fabric Requirements*:

1 yard of black or navy-blue fabric

Craft size batting

Tools Required:

Sewing machine. If you bring your machine, please make sure that it's in working order. We do not have a technician on the premises. The Quilt Tree has classroom machines available for your use.

Inexpensive 5 x7 or 8 x 10 sketch pad

Ultrafine black Sharpie

Freemotion Gloves

New sewing machine needles: 90/14

Free motion or darning foot {Bernina #9,24,29,72,}

BSR (Bernina Stitch Regulator – if you have one)

Small curved fabric scissors

White or light gray Mettler thread

General pastel chalk in white

505 basting spray needed to prepare quilt sandwich.

Pre-class homework: Make ten 8-inch *sandwiches using basting spray.

*Quilt sandwich: front fabric, batting, back fabric
