



## The Quilt Tree

I named this quilt Batik Magic because of the fabric collection of batiks used. The Quilt Tree carries many other fabric collections in fat quarters and on bolt that will work really well with this design. Please don't be shy. Be adventurous. The goal is to make a four patch that contrasts with the "cheater" border that might be different from any of the squares in the four patch. You will have enough material left over from which you might want to make a pillow, pillow case, or accessory piece. The back of the quilt has a Seminole design piece which we might discuss if there is time.

**Pattern Requirements\*:** Chinese Magic by Willow Brook Quilts

**Fabric Requirements\*:**

If buying from a 42" bolt, purchase  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard each of 14 fabrics for the four patch and "cheater" borders around each block. Large prints might not work as well as smaller or medium prints.

If buying fat quarters, purchase 15 varied fat quarter fabrics.

Black fabric (or other primary color of choice): 4 yards for the block borders, sashing strips, setting and corner triangles and binding.

Backing and hanging sleeve: 3-3/4 yards

Batting 65" x 65"

Grey thread for piecing the four patches and black thread for the rest.

**Tools Required:**

Rotary Cutter and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)

Ruler 6 1/2" x 12" or 6 1/2" x 18"

Sewing machine in good working condition with manual

1/4" presser foot

Scissors to cut paper

Pins

Neutral sewing thread

Seam Ripper

Do not worry about borders, binding or backing at this time.
