Pattern Requirement*: "Crisscross Apron Pattern" by Mary Mulari Designs

Fabric/Material Requirements*:

- ☐ Two 1 yard pieces of 42" wide cotton fabric
 - If you are doing pockets on both sides of the apron, please get another ¼ yard of coordinating fabric
- ☐ 1 yard of Pattern Ease Tracing Paper (Optional but recommended)

Tools Required*:

- ☐ Tube Turner (Sookie Sews EZ Point and Turner OR Quick Turn Fabric Tube Turner)
- ☐ Coordinating Thread(s) - to match both fabrics
- ☐ Fabric Scissors
- ☐ Rotary Cutter
- ☐ 6.5"x24" Ruler
- ☐ Marking Tool (Chalk or Frixion Pen)
- ☐ Seam Ripper
- ☐ Clover Clips or Pins
- ☐ Topstitch/Edgestitch foot (Bernina #10)

Pre-Class HW:

1. Purchase the pattern and read through it.
2. **Prepare pattern:**
 - a. Cut out the original paper pattern before class.
 - b. **PATTERN EASE OPTION** - Like most patterns, this pattern is made with paper. After multiple uses, paper tends to get destroyed so I like to use Pattern Ease to trace my pattern onto in order to preserve my original pattern. Pattern Ease is more durable and can be folded away and reused multiple times. If you decide to use Pattern Ease, please trace and cut out the pattern ahead of time. Make sure to mark where the pockets will go.
