In this class you will learn to raw edge collage:

- 1-Preparing the applique piece
- 2-Ironing the prepared applique pieces on to the background fabric
- Remember: this is play time, stress is not allowed in the room

### **Fabric Requirements\*:**

1. One fat quarter for a one-piece background, if you want to piece your background then you'll need a couple more pieces of background fabric. Big scraps work great.
2. Scraps and/or fat quarters for face, facial features, hair, outfit.
3. Large print novelty fabric, flowers, animals, bugs, anything you like
4. Any type of embellishments you would like to use: rick rack, lace, fringe, buttons, beads think outside the box but keep it simple. Not too much.
5. 18 x 22 piece of batting or 1/2 yard fusible fleece
6. 1-1/2 yards of steam a seam

### **Tools Required\*:**

- No Sewing machine needed
- Rotary Cutter with a new blade
- Applique Pressing sheet (optional but a great tool)
- Wool Pressing Mat (optional but a great tool)
- Paper scissors a must
- Karen Kay Buckley 6-inch blue medium scissors a must (best scissors, hands down)

· Mechanical pencils or hard pencils are not too soft and messy (the dollar store has great mechanical pencils)
