

Book/Pattern Requirements*:
Grand Entrance by Coach House Designs

## Fabric Requirements*:

There are twelve blocks in this quilt, made in two different colorways. You can make the pattern with block in two different colorways, as the store sample is made, or you can make all the blocks in one color way. If you choose to do all your blocks the same, double the amount of fabric for Block A (and ignore Block B).

Block A:
$1 / 2$ yard of fabric for three-sided snowballs
3/8 yard of fabric for cradle shaped corners
$1 / 4$ yard for inside cradle shaped blocks
$1 / 4$ yard for blocks inside cradle
Block B:
$1 / 2$ yard of fabric for three sided snowballs
3/8 yard of fabric for cradle shaped corners
$1 / 4$ yard for inside cradle shaped blocks
$1 / 4$ yard for blocks inside cradle
5/8 yard for center of blocks

2 yards neutral fabric for blocks and border
$1-1 / 2$ yards for large outer border (includes $5 / 8$ yard for center of block A)
5/8 yard for binding
3-5/8 yard for backing
Twin size batting

## Tools Required:

Rotary Cutter and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)
Ruler $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 24 " or $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 18 "
Strip Cutter - optional, but highly recommended
Sewing machine in good working condition with manual
Any attachment for your sewing machine which makes $1 / 4$ " seams more precisely.
Fabric scissors
Neutral sewing thread
Pins
Seam Ripper
