

Pattern Requirements*: Hummingbird by Toni Whitney

This Hummingbird raw edge fusible applique quilt pattern by Toni Whitney Design features an in-flight hummingbird poised to get nectar from pink flowers hanging on a vine.

Confident Beginner: A quilter who has pieced and assembled several quilt tops and is comfortable with the process and is now ready to move on to more challenging techniques and projects using at least two different techniques.

Fabric Requirements*:

One fat quarter for background 1/4 yard for border 1/3 yard for inner border and binding 3/4 yards for backing

The rest of the fabric needed can be scraps, check the back of the pattern for colors and sizes. If you don't have scraps in the colors needed get 1/8 yards, 1/4 yard or fat quarters.

1-1/2 yard of Steam a Seam lite.2/3 of a yard of SF101 interfacingCraft size batting

Tools Required:

Sewing machine. If you bring your machine, please make sure that it's in working order. We do not have a technician on the premises. If you leave your machine at home, The Ouilt Tree has classroom machines. Rotary Cutter with a new blade New sewing machine needles: 90/14 1/4" inch foot {Bernina #37, 57, 97} Open toe foot {Bernina #20} Walking foot {Bernina #50} Kay Buckley light blue scissors Small curved fabric scissors **Applique Pressing Sheet** Stiletto by Annie's White or light gray thread for piecing Thread of choice for quilting Ultra-fine sharpie General pastel chalk in white Pins **Clover Wonder Clips** Seam Ripper, manual or battery operated 505 basting spray needed to prepare quilt sandwich Optional-17x17 piece of clear vinyl for tracing the pattern
