Everyone has the ability to be creative, we just need to allow our creativity to grow. Improv is a great way to give yourself permission to play with no rules and no patterns. Learn easy improv techniques to create angled stripes, improv curves and inset strips.

Pattern Requirements*: Artful Improv by Cindy Griselda

Fabric Requirements*:

10 fat quarters that read as solids, such as tone on tone, small scale prints, Kona cottons and my favorite Grunge. Choose either regular cottons or batiks in a variety of light, medium and dark tones.

Warm tones: red, orange, yellow, red orange, yellow green, yellow orange etc.

Cool tones: blue, green, purple, violet, red violet, blue green etc.

Plus a few neutrals: brown, cream, greys, tan, black and white

Tools Required:

Rotary Cutter (with a new blade) and mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)

Ruler 6 1/2" x 24" or 6 1/2" x 18"

Add three-eighths ruler for very thin strips

Any small square rulers you may have: 3-1/2", 4-1/2", 5-1/2", 6-1/2" or 8-1/2"

New sewing machine needles: 90/14

Sewing machine in good working condition with manual

Any attachment for your sewing machine which makes ¼" seams more precisely.

(Bernina #37, #57, #97)

Pins or Clover Wonder Clips

Pencil

Stiletto by Annie

Rotating Cutting Mat Fabric scissors Neutral sewing thread Seam Ripper
