Pattern Requirements*: I Can't Believe It's a Sweatshirt by Gail Abeloe

Fabric Requirements*:

Eight ¼ yards or eight fat quarters

One fat quarter for binding.

One Set in sleeve sweatshirt, choose a sweatshirt one or two sizes larger. Do not wash.

Tools Required*:

Sewing machines: If you prefer to use your personal machine, please ensure it is functioning properly. Alternatively, you are welcome to use the machines we provide, as the class will focus on basic straight-line sewing.

If you have a Bernina, bring your #37, #57 or #97. If not, bring a ¼" foot for your machine.

Rotary Cutter with a new blade and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)

505 purple temporary adhesive glue stick

By Annie's Stiletto and Pressing Tool (highly recommend)

3 or 4 Decorative threads to match sweatshirts

One decorative button (optional)

Set of Two 14mm magnets (by Annie)

Ruler 6 1/2" x 24" or 6 1/2" x 18"

Pins

Fabric scissors

Neutral sewing thread

Seam Ripper
