



The Quilt Tree

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Supply List: Jungle Collage

Date: Tuesday, December 1st, 8th, 15th

You have a choice of making a quilt with stripes, a checkerboard or pillow.

Fabric Requirements*:

Either the striped quilt or the checkerboard quilt needs:

1 animal panel (sold at shop)

1/3 yard for narrow inner borders (Border 1 and 3)

2/3 yard for border 2 (wider middle border)

Additionally:

If you are doing the stripes (as on the Rhino) you need about 3 ½ yards of fabric. I used 1/3 yard each of 9 different fabrics. My stripes are cut 1-½ " wide. You could use a jelly roll (2-½ ") if you so desire.

If you choose to do the checkerboard (as on the Impala) you need 1-2/3 of each of 2 colors.

BUT:

If you only want to do a pillow you need:

1 animal panel

20" square batting

Fat quarter for pillow back

Fat quarter for bias cut strips for piping

2-1/4 yards of 1/4" or 3/8" cording

1/2 yard muslin or neutral scrap fabric ("backing" for the front of pillow, which will be quilted)

Tools Required:

Rotary Cutter and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)

Ruler 6 1/2" x 24" or 6 1/2" x 18"

Sewing machine in good working condition with manual (Please note that you are welcome to use our classroom machines)

Any attachment which makes $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams more precisely. if you bring your sewing machine.

Pins

Fabric scissors

Neutral sewing thread

Seam Ripper
