Finished Quilt Size: 66" x 72"

Pattern Requirements*: Looking Up by Wendy Williams

Fabric Requirements*:

Background for applique – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards

Printed fabrics for blocks – $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of about 20 different fabrics

Stem fabrics – fat quarters of 4 fabrics

Wool for flower applique (or cotton fabrics and steam a seam if you don't want to use wool)

The choice for the applique is either wool and hand embroidery or

Cotton fabrics and machine applique.

If you choose wool:

Wool pieces in flower and leaf colors

Perle 8 cotton thread or DCM or and hand embroidery threads to match or contrast with your

flowers and leaves

Chenille needles #24

Milliners Needle #3

Freezer paper

If you want to use cotton and machine applique:

Cotton fabrics for flowers and leaves

12 wt cotton thread in colors to match or contrast with your flowers and leaves

1 yard steam a seam (or other fusible)

Tools Required:

Rotary Cutter and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)

Ruler 6 1/2" x 24" or 6 1/2" x 18"

Sewing machine in good working condition with manual (Please note that you are welcome to use our classroom machines)

Any attachment which makes 1/4" seams more precisely. if you bring your sewing machine.

Pins

Fabric scissors

Neutral sewing thread

Seam Ripper

Pre class Homework:

In the first class we will be working on the center embroidery piece. Cut your background piece to 19' x 19".
