Pattern: "Foundation Paper for the Wensleydale Quilt" from Jen Kingwell Designs

This pattern is from the book "Quilt Recipes" by Jen Kingwell. This is a beautiful hard cover book with great scrap patterns and cooking recipes. (Optional). We will be making a few blocks from the pattern

Fabric Requirements for Class*: Scrap Buster!

NOTE: For Class you just need to bring a bag of scraps, make sure that the pieces are ironed.

Optional: Additional fabric if you are planning to make the entire quilt:

7 to 8 yards of variety of cuts of fabric: fat sixteenth or fat eights or scraps work great
Backing fabric 4 ½ yards
Binding 5/8 yards
Twin size batting

Tools Required:

Sewing machines are available at the store. If you choose to bring your own machine, please make sure that it's in working order as we do not have a technician on the premises.

Rotary Cutter with a new blade

Ruler 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24" or smaller. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares are also helpful.

*1/4-inch foot (Bernina #37, 57, 97. If you have a Bernina, please bring your own feet, bobbin, and bobbin case)

Fabric scissors

Seam ripper or The Quick Ripper (great for paper piecing!)

Clover clips or thin pins

Clapper (optional)

Precision Piecing Seam Align Gentle hold fabric glue (optional)

Precision Piecing Easy press pen, great for flat seams (optional)

Gypsy Quilter Wool Pressing mat great for flat seams (optional) 505 basting Spray
