



## The Quilt Tree

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**Supply List: "Patchwork Duffle"**

### Pattern Requirements\*:

- "Patchwork Duffle" by Knot and Thread Design**

### Fabric Requirements\*:

This is called the "Patchwork" Duffle because it can be made by piecing 3 ½" squares together (patchwork version), but please note that for this class, we will be doing the one fabric version.

- Main Fabric** – 1 yard
- Lining Fabric** – 1 yard
- Exterior Accent Fabric** (Binding & Handles) – ½ yard
- Interior Accent Fabric** (Bias Binding) – One Fat Quarter
- "Soft and Stable"** – One 36" x 58" package
- Handbag Zippers** – One 30" Zipper OR a package of zippers by the yard
- 1.5" Handle webbing** (polypro strapping) – 3 & 5/8 yard

### Tools Required\*:

- Thread(s)** to match your fabrics and zippers
- ByAnnie's Stiletto and Pressing Tool** (highly recommended)
- Rotary Cutter and Mat** (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)
- Ruler** 6 1/2" x 24"
- Fabric scissors**
- Seam Ripper**
- Clover Clips** – I absolutely love these clips! These are important and highly recommended. You will need these clips to hold the pieces together while sewing as the layers are too thick for pins. The clips come in either a 10-pack or a 50-pack. The 10-pack is probably not enough for this project, but you can try. It might be worth investing in a 50-pack because you will find these clips indispensable for any project that involves thick layers. Also, it's fantastic for attaching binding on a quilt.

- Marking Tool** like a frixion pen, pastel pencil, Clover Chaco Liner etc.
- 1 package of size 90 Topstitch or Jeans needles**
- Sewing machine** – You are welcome to use the machines in the shop.  
However, if you should decide to bring in your own machine, please make sure that it is in good working condition.
- Presser Feet:**
  - **1/4" foot** (Bernina Foot #37)
  - **Edge stitch foot** (Bernina Foot #10)
  - **Walking foot** (not necessary but highly recommended – if you own a Bernina Walking foot, please bring it to class)

**Before Class Homework:**

Please be sure to purchase all of your fabric before the first class.
