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**Supply List: Raw Edge Machine Applique 101**

In this class you will learn to raw edge machine applique in three simple steps:

- 1-Preparing the applique piece
- 2-Ironing the prepared applique pieces on to the background fabric
- 3-Sewing it in place with blanket stitch

**Book Requirement\*:** Teach me to Applique by Pat Sloan

### **Fabric Requirements\*:**

1/4 yard of 2 assorted cream prints for the background  
3/8 yard for narrow inner border and single fold binding  
3/8 yard for outer border  
1 fat quarter for flower petals  
1 fat quarter of a medium green for stems  
1 fat quarter for vase  
1 fat quarter for center of flowers  
1-5/8 for backing  
3/4 yard Fusible fleece

### **Tools Required:**

Sewing machine. If you bring your machine, please make sure that it's in working order. We do not have a technician on the premises. The Quilt Tree has machines that you can use in class.  
Rotary Cutter and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)  
Rotary Cutter with a new blade  
Ruler 6 1/2 x 24 (Please bring your ruler!)  
Yellow bias tape maker (optional but helpful)  
Neutral thread for piecing  
Thread to match your appliques  
505 basting spray

¼ foot (if you have a Bernina, it's a number 37, 57, or 97)

Open toe foot (if you have a Bernina, it's number 20)

Small scissors

Seam ripper

Mechanical pencil or hard pencil not a #2 too soft (the dollar store has great mechanical pencils)

Clover clips or pins

**If you have a Bernina, please bring your own feet, bobbin, and bobbin case.**
