Pattern Requirements*:

Quilts in America by Kaffe Fassett

Fabric Requirements*:

This quilt is a traditional tumbling blocks pattern arranged in circles. There is one square in the center, row 1 consists of 6 blocks, row 2 consists of 12 blocks, row 3 consists of 18 blocks, row 4 of 24 blocks, row 5 of 30 blocks, row 6 of 32 blocks, row 7 of 9 blocks and there are four corner blocks. Each block consists of three fabrics: one light, one medium and one dark. (Note that in the sample quilt, rows 3 and 6 used the same fabric. If you want to use different fabrics, you will have to adjust the yardage.)

1/8 yard of three fabrics, one light, one medium and one dark for the center square

1/4 yard of three fabrics, one light, one medium and one dark for each of Row 1, Row 2, Row 7 and corners

1/2 yard of three fabrics, one light, one medium and one dark for Row 4

3/4 yard of three fabrics, one light one medium and one dark for Row 5

1 yard of three fabrics, one light, one medium and one dark for Rows 3 and 6

Twin batting

5-1/2 yards for backing

4/8 yard for binding

Tools Required:

Clearview Triangle Mini Super 60° Acrylic Ruler

Rotary Cutter and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)

Ruler 6 1/2" x 24" or 6 1/2" x 18"

Sewing machine in good working condition with manual

Any attachment for your sewing machine which makes 1/4" seams more precisely.

Pins
Fabric scissors
Neutral sewing thread
Seam Ripper
Add-a-quarter ruler
