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### **Supply List: Improv Patchwork**

In this class we will be exploring a variety of ways to piece original prints out of solid fabrics. By cutting and combining solid color fabrics to create your own prints. This is a technique-based workshop, but we will discuss how to take these techniques and create a final composition. No rulers and stitch freely to create a unique art quilt that pack a punch.

**Pattern Requirements\*:** Improv Patchwork, Dynamic Shapes made with Lines and Shape by Maria Shell

### **Fabric Requirements\*:**

8 to 12 half yard cuts of solid colors fabric. Try to represent the entire color wheel and not just your favorite colors. Kona cotton is a great choice but it's not your only choice. The Quilt Tree has an amazing collect of solids.

Half yard cuts of white, brown, grey, black and stripes.

### **Tools Required:**

Rotary Cutter with a new blade and Mat (leave your mat at home and use ours while you're in class)

Ruler 6 1/2" x 24" or 4" x 14"

Sewing machine in good working condition with manual or use ours

1/4" piecing foot

90/14 top stitch needle

Fabric scissors

Grey or taupe sewing thread

Seam Ripper

Paper or notepad to take notes
