Tools Required:

18" x 2" Clear Plastic Ruler

60" Tape Measure

Seam Gauge/Point Turner

Long Pins with bead head

Magnetic Pin Holder (or other small holder)

Marking Chalk or Pencil

Small Scissors (Storks)

Fabric Shears

Seam Ripper

Sewing Machine with User Manual (you may use classroom machine)

Bobbins

Feet (adjustable zipper)

Machine Needles

Class #1

Review the "tools required" list.

Learn how to thread and use the sewing machine.

Sew samples of all of the stitches.

Learn the grain lines on fabrics.

Make a sample of the grain lines marked on the fabric.

Materials Needed:

1/2 yard of muslin fabric

1 spool of contrasting thread

Class #2

Cut and sew a reversible shopping bag.

Materials Needed:

1/2 yard each of 2 coordinating cotton fabrics

1 spool of matching thread

Pattern will be provided

Class #3

Cut and sew a small zippered pouch.

Materials Needed:

Triplizip Pattern

1/2 yard of cotton fabrics (or fat quarter)

1/2 yard of contrasting cotton fabric (or fat quarter)

1 9" zipper

1 spool of matching thread

Class #4

Cut and sew an apron.

Materials Needed:

Crisscross Apron Pattern

2 one yard pieces of cotton fabric

Thread to match both fabrics

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
