

## ***ByAnnie Night and Day Purse***

First, thank you for trusting in me to guide you through the process of making your very own Night and Day Purse.

You will need to purchase all of your fabric, Soft & Stable, fusible interfacing, zipper(s), hardware and other notions to make the Purse. Remember, as a Stitcher's Quest class participant, you receive a class discount on all notions and fabric purchased for this class.

Your pattern has a code to access the Add-On Video for this pattern. To access the video, create (or go to) your ByAnnie account, 'purchase' the video, and use the code for payment. The video will then download automatically. This video may be helpful in placing your fabric as well as the various construction points highlighted in the video.

When choosing your fabric, please be mindful if it is directional. This will make a difference when you start cutting out the pieces, especially for the front and back of the bag.

We will be using pages 1 through 9 in the construction of the purse, as well as the labels at the end of the pattern. The remainder of the pattern refers to the reversible tote...which we will save for another class.

### **As part of the preparation for the class, you will need to accomplish the following:**

Cut out and quilt all pieces as indicated on Page 2. Using the labels provided, pin the labels to the fabric as you cut each piece. BE SURE TO READ THE IMPORTANT NOTE AT THE START OF THE CUT AND QUILT SECTION (I) because there are two sections to this purse.

The front "Border" is listed under "Lining Fabric" (non-quilted) as a 3"x26" strip. This can be made from another fabric you would like to highlight, just taking note that the strip will be folded in half to 3"x13" with the right side of the piece being visible on the front of the bag.

One change I suggest to the pattern is to cut the carrying strap (non-quilted main fabric) 3"x42" and 3"x20". This will make it easier when covering the strapping.
