

# SUNFLOWER POWER

**Supply list for class on Monday, May 9th at 10:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

Backing Fabric - 14" x 22"

Batting - 14" x 22"

1 - Jelly roll or at least 25-30 pieces of selvage edge fabric at least 1 1/2" wide.

(Make sure you have a good assortment of colors with 1/3 of the amount being light colored.)

Leaves and stem:

3 - Fat quarters in green -

1-dark patterned color,

1 medium patterned color and

1 - medium light patterned color

Flower:

2 - fat quarters in different shades of patterned yellow

1 - fat quarter in brown

Binding -

2- strips - 2 1/2" x 44" of a color of your choice

Sewing machine

Scissors

24" ruler

hot glue gun and 2 to 3 sticks of glue

black and white thread plus 2 threaded bobbins ( or black thread plus whatever color to match your backing fabric.)

quilting straight pins

rotary cutter

hand stitching needle

2 sharpened pencils
