

COVID Protocols for Mountain to Sound Outfitters Ski Swap

We will be using physical distancing during the 2020 Ski Swap to keep people safe while also helping people get geared up to outside and enjoy the 2020-21 winter. It is of the utmost importance that we all work together to make this a successful event and to avoid any potential spread of any type of sickness.

The VFW Hall has a capacity of 250 people. To that effect, we will allow 50 people at a time in the hall to shop. We ask that people be conscious of others waiting and spend ½ hour in the hall. We will be handing out wrist bands, and will note the time of entry on the wrist bands.

Upon entry everyone will be required to undergo a temperature check. Anyone that is sick will not be allowed in the hall. We will also spray each participant's hands with Alcohol based hand sanitizer. All entry participants will list name, contact phone number and email on a check in sheet. Masks will be required by everyone to enter the hall. Hand sanitizer will also be located throughout the area.

Staff will be provided with face shields and will also be required to wear masks. We will provide nitrile gloves for people working the swap.

The entry this year will change to the North Facing entrance with the goal of having the line head down Alaska St towards the West. We have A BBQ vendor coming and will provide BBQ by the line.

The exit will be the NE corner of the hall. We will have someone at the exit communicating with the entry door person. Cashiers will be lined up by the exit as well, and we will have someone taking gear in at the hall as well for Tunes/Mounts so they are not required to go into M2S.
