

Stargazer Quilt

Finished size: 48" x 48"

Fabric Selection:

This pattern uses 8 fabrics. Confident quilters can add more, if desired.

- Select fabrics from a “collection” with a range of colors and several blenders; or choose your own fabrics. [A collection is a group of fabrics developed together by a fabric designer that blend well. Ruby Street displays fabrics in their ‘collections’ to make fabric selection easier.]
- Instructions include two ‘focus fabrics’ or fabrics with a large enough print to look nice in a 6” block. These can be ‘fussy cut’.
- There are two different background fabrics, either light or dark with minimal pattern that will blend into the background and coordinate with the other fabrics.
- Select the rest of the fabrics to coordinate with the two focus fabrics and background.
- Feel free to copy and then color the diagram on the following page to get an idea of fabric placement.

Yardage needed, cutting instructions and notes:

WOF = width of fabric. Calculations are based on 42” wide fabric. If your fabric is less than 42” you may need more yardage.

FQ = Fat Quarter

Fabric Code	Note	Yardage Needed
F1	Focus Fabric	¼ yard * or FQ
F2	Focus Fabric	¼ yard *
A		¼ yard or FQ
B1	Background – light value	1 ¼ yard
B2	Background – coordinate color with Fabric E	½ yard
C	Star Points	½ yard
D	Something that stands out a little	½ yard
E	Coordinate of B2	¼ yard or FQ

* Or more fabric to fussy cut
