

Sparkle—A Modern Stashbuster Quilt



Sparkle is a slightly wonky "modern scrappy" block that uses the background of the block to create a secondary pattern in the overall project with lots of options. Slightly maverick piecing is forgiving and the quilt is full of movement. (If you prefer more precise piecing, foundation paper patterns are also provided.) This is a great project to use up scraps in your favorite colors, or change up the color groups to match your favorite sports team, a holiday, etc. You'll start cutting fabric sets and learn how to make the wonky star blocks. We'll also review the paper piecing method. Quilt finishes at 60" x 60".

Pacific Grove Lap Quilt



We've made our sample with Free Spirit's "Paradise" fabric for a taste of the tropics, even if you can't get away on a Caribbean cruise! Wouldn't this look great on the porch or at the beach? The confident beginner will love this pattern from Villa Rosa Designs.



Mondo Bag


