Unless you are taking "Sewing Machine Basics Class" you will need to have a basic knowledge of how your sewing machine works. Our instructors will be focusing their time towards the lesson at hand. You should know how to properly thread your machine, wind a bobbin, change the needle, change the feet and access the stitch settings.

YOUR SEWING MACHINE

1. It all begins with a well running sewing machine. Before class ensure your machine is clean and ready to sew.
2. Foot Pedal and Power Cord.
3. Owners Manual.
4. Spare needles
5. A couple empty bobbins.
6. Any presser feet that will be required for your project.
7. Screw driver, oil and micro-tip cleaning brush to clear and clean a thread jam.

TOOLS

1. Small thread snips
2. 45 mm Rotary Cutter
3. Seam ripper
4. Fabric marking chalk pencil or pen
5. Straight pins
6. Fabric Clips
7. Utility scissors
8. Stiletto
9. Mini Iron (optional)
10. Hand sewing Needle.

NOTIONS & MEASURING

1. Best Press
2. Thread to match your fabrics
3. 6 x 12 inch ruler or 2 X 12 inch ruler
4. 60 inch tape measure
5. Hot Hemmer (optional)
6. Post-It Notes
7. Pen/Pencil
